HIGHLIGHTS FROM MILWAUKEE COUNTY BOARD MEETING: SEPTEMBER 25, 2014

15-2 (No: Alexander, Borkowski) Requesting the Audit Services Division conduct an audit of Supporting Homecare Options.

16-1 (No: Weishan) Requesting authorization to enter into FY 2015 Purchase of Service Contracts with the Social Development Commission.

10-7 (No: Alexander, Bowen, Lipscomb, Mayo, Staskunas, Taylor, Weishan) To refer to Finance, Personnel and Audit Committee a request for authorization to enter into a consulting and call center services contract with Xerox State and Local Services.

16-1 (No: Weishan) Requesting a waiver of Milwaukee County Code of General Ordinances and authorizing payment in an amount not to exceed \$4,076 to Quorum Architects for organization, facilitation and summarization of Milwaukee County's City Campus Community Visioning Session.
