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HIGHLIGHTS FROM MILWAUKEE COUNTY BOARD MEETING: JULY 31, 2014

- 13-4 (NO: Alexander, Borkowski, Schmitt, Taylor) To override a veto of a resolution providing for an advisory referendum on the November 4, 2014 election ballot on whether Milwaukee County voters support increasing the State minimum wage to \$10.10 per hour.
- 13-4 (NO: Alexander, Borkowski, Schmitt, Taylor) To override a veto of a resolution providing for an advisory referendum on the November 4, 2014, election ballot on whether Milwaukee County voters support the State Legislature accepting monies from the Federal government to expand BadgerCare.
- 12-5 (NO: Alexander, Jursik, Lipscomb, Schmitt, Taylor) To override a veto of a resolution providing for an advisory referendum on whether Milwaukee County voters support the State amending the Wisconsin Statutes to allow Milwaukee County to transition its management and administrative functions from an elected County Executive to a professional County Administrator.
- 15-2 (NO: Mayo, Rainey) Appointing Janet Cleary to the Milwaukee County Civil Service Commission.
- 11-6 (NO: Alexander, Bowen, Johnson, Mayo, Rainey, Romo West) Requesting a 120-day extension of the Temporary Assignment to a Higher Classification for Scott Wisniewski to continue serving as the Asst. Chief of Airport Rescue and Firefighting at General Mitchell International Airport.
- 14-3 (NO: Borkowski, Cullen, Staskunas) Requesting authorization to extend Airport Agreement No. CN-1906 between Milwaukee County and SSP, Inc. at General Mitchell International Airport for a term of five years.
- 14-3 (NO: Jursik, Taylor, Weishan) Submitting a 2014 Appropriation Packet for the July 2014 cycle.
- 10-7 (NO: Borkowski, Broderick, Cullen, Rainey, Staskunas, Taylor, Weishan) Requesting authorization to allocate \$3.5 million in insurance proceeds to the Debt Service Budget and to reduce contribution from the Debt Service Reserve Fund to the Debt Service Budget by the same amount.

- 14-3 (NO: Alexander, Borkowski, Jursik) Rejection of informational reports relative to Reclassification of Existing positions, Advancement within the Pay Range; Revisions to Executive Compensation Plan Appointments; Dual Employment Emergency Appointments; and Temporary Assignments to Higher Classifications.
- 8-9 (NO: Bowen, Broderick, Cullen, Haas, Johnson, Mayo, Rainey, Romo West, Weishan) To refer to Corporation Counsel a resolution providing for an advisory referendum on the November 4, 2014, ballot on whether tax revenue should be used to help pay for the renovation or construction of a new sports and entertainment arena to replace the BMO Harris Bradley Center in the City of Milwaukee and to build a major expansion to the Wisconsin Center Convention Center. (Minority rule; six votes needed to refer)
- 15-2 (NO: Alexander, Jursik) Requesting authorization to renew Airport Agreement No. HP-695 between Milwaukee County and Mondelez Global, LLC, to establish four renewal periods of three years effective July 1, 2015.
- 14-3 (NO: Alexander, Staskunas, Taylor) Requesting authorization for payment for DAS-Economic Development Expenditures allocated in the 2014 Milwaukee County Adopted Operating Budget.
- 11-6 (NO: Jursik, Lipscomb, Schmitt, Staskunas, Taylor, Dimitrijevic) To suspend the rules to consider a resolution providing for an advisory referendum on the Nov. 4, 2014 election ballot on whether tax revenue should be used to help pay for the renovation or construction of a new sports and entertainment arena to replace the BMO Harris Bradley Center in the City of Milwaukee and to build a major expansion to the Wisconsin Center Convention Center. (Two-thirds vote needed for consideration.)
