RESULTS FROM MILWAUKEE COUNTY BOARD MEETING: November 6, 2014

- 7-10 (No: Alexander, Bowen, Cullen, Haas, Jursik, Lipscomb, Romo West, Staskunas, Taylor, Dimitrijevic) To oppose any new tax to help pay for the renovation or construction of a new sports arena to replace the BMO Harris Bradley.
- 16-1 (No: Weishan) To enter into a contract with Aramark Correctional Services for the provision of food services to the Milwaukee County Jail and House of Correction.
- 16-1 (No: Weishan) To enter into a non-professional services contract with Aramark Corp. for the provision of food service to the Delinquency and Court Services division.
- 13-4 (No: Broderick, Rainey, Romo West, Weishan) To execute a contract between Milwaukee County and AlliedBarton Security Services for the provision of security in County facilities.
- 15-2 (No: Alexander, Jursik) Rejection of informational reports from the Deputy Director of the Dept. of Human Resources relative to reclassification of existing positions, advancements within the pay range, reallocations of non-represented positions; appointments at an advanced step of the pay range; revisions to executive compensation plan positions; dual employment, emergency appointments; temporary appointments and temporary assignments to a higher classification.
- 16-1 (No: Weishan) Requesting authorization to enter into a lease agreement with the City of Greenfield to rent the Greenfield Communication Room at an annual cost of \$1 for a term of 15 years.
- 16-1 (No: Alexander) To refer to committee a request to authorize a lease with the Milwaukee Kickers Soccer Club, Inc. for the use of Uihlein Soccer park.
- 16-1 (No: Jursik) Requesting authorization to enter into a building lease agreement with Sleep Environment Innovations at Milwaukee County's MKE Regional Business Park.

- 16-1 (No: Weishan) Authorizing issuance of airport revenue bonds to increase the time for filing audited statements and to clarify the role of the Auditor.
- 15-2 (No: Lipscomb, Weishan) To refer to committee a resolution relating to disorderly conduct concerning transit services for Milwaukee County.
- 14-3 (No: Alexander, Staskunas, Taylor) To lay over until December 18 a request for authorization to declare the O'Donnell Parking Structure surplus and requesting authorization for the County to enter into a Purchase Agreement with Northwestern Mutual for the purchase of the property.
- 14-3 (No: Borkowski, Taylor, Weishan) Requesting authorization to enter into a bus service agreement with Southridge Shopping Center and to reroute bus routes accordingly.
