RESULTS FROM MILWAUKEE COUNTY BOARD MEETING, APRIL 25, 2013

- 14-4 (No: Mayo, Romo West, Stamper, Weishan) to refer a veto by the County Executive to committee. Original resolution allows for amending a section of the Milwaukee County Code of General Ordinances as necessary to align the definition of Small Business Enterprise with the Small Business Opportunity Initiative approved in the 2013 Milwaukee County Adopted Operating Budget (Item 68)
- 12-6 (No: Broderick, Cullen, Jursik, Romo West, Schmitt, Staskunas) to amend the lease agreement between Milwaukee County and Rite-Hite Holding Corporation (Item 51)
- 12-6 (No: Broderick, Cullen, Jursik, Romo West, Schmitt, Staskunas) to enter into a new lease agreement between Milwaukee County and Diamond Aviation, LLC, for the least of land on which to maintain a hangar facility at General Mitchell International Airport (Item 52)
- 12-6 (No: Broderick, Cullen, Jursik, Romo West, Schmitt, Staskunas) to enter into a new hangar lease agreement with Arnold M. Guida (Item 57)
- 16-2 (No: Alexander and Taylor) to establish an off-airport parking operator privilege fee at General Mitchell International Airport and enter into agreements with off-airport parking operators to establish fees for use of the Airport (Item 60)
- 2-16 (Aye: Alexander and Borkowski) on a substitute resolution to Resolution 13-397. It requests the convening of the County Board Committee of the Whole as a forum for all Supervisors to offer suggestions for County Board reform. The resolution further directs the Board's Intergovernmental Relations staff to stop expressing opposition to State Assembly Bill 85 and Senate Bill 95, and instead work with State Legislators toward the inclusion of a series of listed amendments to the State legislation (Item 65)
- 15-3 (No: Alexander, Taylor, Weishan) on a resolution to reform and define the roles and responsibilities of the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors as the policy-making body and the administrative duties of the County Executive, as determined locally (Item 65)
- 14-4 (No: Alexander, Borkowski, Staskunas, Taylor) on a resolution opposing State Assembly Bill 85 and Senate Bill 95 (Item 66)
- 12-6 (No: Haas, Johnson, Mayo, Stamper, Weishan, Dimitrijevic) to refer resolution authorizing and directing Corporation Counsel to retain outside legal counsel to review the provisions of AB85 and SB95 to the Judiciary, Safety and General Services Committee (Item 67)
