


Q1 How do you feel about this general statement? “Milwaukee County is moving in the right direction by doing more with less and holding the tax levy under the rate of inflation.”







Q4 Where should decisions about the budget, operation and organization of Milwaukee County government be made?



Q5 I think significant cuts should be made to the following levels of government. (Check any that apply)








