People of Milwaukee County's 10th District,

I've had the honor to represent you in Milwaukee County government, now in my second year. Serving in the legislative branch, County Supervisors are challenged by problems that have plagued Milwaukee County for years – funding important services you and your families rely on. Lately, your right to have a balanced and accountable government was attacked. No single person or group should be able to control millions of dollars of public resources, but that has clearly been the goal of some.

No matter what County Exec. Chris Abele, the State Legislature, or Gov. Scott Walker do to take away our power, I will work hard on your behalf to protect your interests and maintain County services and assets for County taxpayers.

You need transit to get around, health services to get well, good housing, good jobs, and good parks that allow you to enjoy a high quality of life in Milwaukee County, no matter your income bracket. I'm optimistic because I know more people are paying attention and expecting more outcomes from their elected leaders. I welcome your high expectations of me. Let's work to push our community forward together!

## STATE ACTIONS IMPACT COUNTY RESIDENTS

Lately Legislators in Madison haven't been working in favor of Milwaukee County. Here's an update:

- **County Board limited:** With Act 14, the Governor and Legislature took power and budget dollars away from County Supervisors and increased powers of County Executive. Next spring, you will vote "No or Yes" to cut Supervisors' salary in half with no benefits, but the **Executive's \$131,000** salary will stay the same at 5 times what Sup. David Bowen would make.
- **Residency requirements:** The Governor and Legislature ended local residency rules. Now, public sector **jobs are no longer** preserved for Milwaukee County residents.
- **Transit:** The Governor and Legislature **failed** to increase funding for 2014, leaving a substantial hole in the County budget. Slight increase in 2015.
- **Health care:** The Governor and Legislature **rejected** federal "Obama Care" funding. This will force nearly 90,000 people out of the BadgerCare program.
- **Foreclosure Settlement Money:** Funds that should have been used to help foreclosure victims are **instead** being used to close holes in the State Budget.

## PARKS UNDER CONSTRUCTION



**Moody Park**  
22nd St. & Burleigh St.

- Full park revitalization, including new community building, splash pad, basketball courts, football/soccer field, community garden plots, walking paths, lighting, and open-air pavilion/theater. Expected completion fall 2014.

**Johnsons Park**  
17th St. & Fond Du Lac Ave.

- New open air pavilion with restrooms. Expected completion fall 2013.

**Lindbergh Park**  
16th St. & Nash St.

- New open air cookout pavilion with restrooms and summer splash pad. Expected completion summer 2013.

**Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King Community Center**  
17th St. & Vliet St.

- New heating ventilation air conditioning (HVAC) system. Expected completion summer 2014.

## BOARD WINS TRANSFER OF THE HOUSE OF CORRECTION

- Several years ago, Sheriff David Clarke was appointed to run the Milwaukee County House of Correction (HOC) in Franklin. He changed it from a center of rehabilitation to another County Jail.
- In the 2013 Budget process Supervisor Bowen worked with colleagues to transfer leadership to a Superintendent who will restore essential programs the Sheriff removed.
- Leadership of the House of Corrections has been turned over to a new Superintendent. He is committed and experienced in implementing programs that will develop clients' skills, helping them to stay out of the revolving door of recidivism, and saving the county millions over time.
