10th DISTRICT LANDMARKS GET MUCH NEEDED IMPROVEMENTS

Milwaukee, WI – Milwaukee County Supervisor Eyon Biddle, Sr. is applauding that fact that three Milwaukee County landmarks within the 10th Supervisory District will soon receive long overdue maintenance.

“These projects are exciting wins for the people of the 10th District. When I ran for this County Board seat, I pledged to improve the quality of life for residents. These projects are a step closer to fulfilling the promise I made to the people I represent,” said Supervisor Biddle.

The projects include roof repairs at the Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Community Center, and the Marcia P. Coggs Human Services Center and a new playground area for Johnson’s Park, which will be completed by this spring.

Although Supervisor Biddle is pleased with the progress that has been made in the district, he is cautioning against declaring full victory, because there is still more work that needs to be done.

“We still have a lot more to do, including expanding Johnson’s Park, revitalizing Tiefenthaler Park, replacing the HVAC system at the King Center, and moving forward with plans to renovate Moody Pool,” said Supervisor Biddle.
