**SUPERVISOR BOWEN ANNOUNCES PUBLIC MEETING
TO DISCUSS FUTURE OF MOODY POOL & PARK**
September 6, 2012 Meeting to Address Renovation Plans

Milwaukee, WI – Supervisor David Bowen, District 10, is inviting all members of the community interested in the future of Moody Park and Pool to a public meeting on Thursday, September 6, 2012 from 6 to 7:30 p.m. at COA’s Goldin Center at 2320 W. Burleigh Street in Milwaukee.

“Moody Park, where the defunct Moody Pool sits boarded up, has been an eyesore at best and a magnet for trouble for nearly a decade,” said Supervisor Bowen. “It’s critical that we revitalize the park so it can be the great, community resource it was meant to be: a place for children to play and for residents to exercise and recreate.”

Supervisor David Bowen is sponsoring the public meeting in collaboration with Supervisor Willie Johnson, Jr., the Milwaukee County Parks Department, the Office of the County Executive and COA.

“We are glad the County Executive sees the restoration of Moody Park as a priority, which it has not been for years,” noted Supervisor Bowen. “I’m committed to helping create the sort of place that neighbors want -- whether it include a senior center or a community garden – so they can safely enjoy the park again.”
