Edgerton Ave. & Ramsey Ave. Scheduled to Reopen



As part of the I-94 North-South Freeway Project, the Wisconsin Department of Transportation is continuing construction at Edgerton Avenue and Ramsey Avenue.

Beginning Thursday, September 1st, Edgerton Avenue and Ramsey Avenue from 20th Street to 13th Street are scheduled to reopen to vehicles. These streets were reopened to pedestrians in May 2011. Although the roads will be opened, continuing roadwork will occur in the area, and motorists should be aware of changing traffic patterns and construction workers in the area.

Residents living near the construction site are also reminded to keep off of the construction site for safety purposes, and be watchful of pets and small children. This work will create construction noise, dust and some vibrations. Residents may also observe an increase in construction vehicles in the area.

All work is weather-dependent and subject to change. The project team thanks you for your patience and cooperation throughout the course of this project.

College Avenue Reconstruction Update

College Avenue, west of Pennsylvania Avenue, will soon have a roundabout. The City of Milwaukee has been building roundabouts for several years, such as on S. Sixth Street between Virginia Street and Florida Street. This may be the first one on a County road. The construction should be done in November of this year. College Avenue was closed between Pennsylvania and Howell, to make way for the airport runway safety zone construction.
