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## **COMMITTEE APPROVES CHANGE TO RESIDENCY ORDINANCE**

**Milwaukee, WI** – The County Board’s Finance, Personnel & Audit Committee this afternoon approved a Resolution and Ordinance change authored by Supervisor David Cullen regarding waivers for the County’s employee residency requirements.

Milwaukee County Ordinances state that any employee appointed to the unclassified service shall have six months from the date of hire to establish Milwaukee County residency, but may be granted a six month extension or have the residency requirement waived under certain circumstances.

The Ordinance change approved by the Committee added language to provide that any future waivers be approved by the County Board.

The issue came to light after the Human Resources Director granted a six month extension and a waiver, which did not require County Board approval, for the Economic Development Director.

The full County Board will consider the proposed Resolution and Ordinance change at its next meeting on June 28.

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
