Resolution 16-738

A resolution opposing all forms of discrimination, and affirming Milwaukee County's commitment to value all people equally, regardless of race, sex, class, religion, sexual orientation, gender identity and expression, disability, age, ancestry or nationality, ethnicity, political or religious affiliation, or creed.

This resolution went to the Health and Human needs committee where it was voted 2-2; therefore it went to the full Board where it passed with a 12-6 vote.

Supervisor Sebring was in opposition of the resolution with this quote, "In case you haven't noticed, President Trump is playing hard ball, he's not making threats, he's making promises and he's keeping them. Milwaukee County is



already on a Dept. of Justice Double Secret Probation list of Sanctuaries. And should this resolution pass, we can expect to get millions of dollars of Federal Grant money cut in June. That is federal grant money that Milwaukee cannot deliver essential services to its residents without. Regardless where you stand on this resolution, the risk is too high and the potential cost is too great. I am not going to go back to my district and tell my constituents that I voted to eliminate transit, law enforcement, the court system, renovating the Domes, improvements to the Airport, and to the park system and to the zoo so people can *feel* better about living here."

GO Pass News

PRESCRIPTION DRUG DISCOUNT CARD

Program Highlights:

- There is no need to enroll, the card is valid immediately
- The discount card is valid for prescriptions not covered by insurance
- Each prescription has a different discount, average savings is 20%
- Any Milwaukee County resident is eligible to use these discount cards
- This plan is not insurance it is a discount (like a coupon) for prescriptions
- The card may only be used at participating pharmacies
