SUPERVISOR STEVE F. TAYLOR APPOINTED BY GOV. SCOTT WALKER TO MILWAUKEE CHILD WELFARE PARTNERSHIP COUNCIL

Milwaukee County Supervisor Steve F. Taylor has been appointed to the Milwaukee Child Welfare Partnership Council by Gov. Scott Walker.

It is also responsible for identifying innovative public and private funding opportunities for the child welfare system in Milwaukee County, as well as submitting its recommendations with respect to those funding opportunities. The Council also advises the Wisconsin Department of Children and Families in planning and technical assistance to support a neighborhood-based system of delivery of child welfare services within the County.
