SUPERVISOR TAYLOR APPOINTED TO EASTERN WISCONSIN COUNTIES RAILROAD CONSORTIUM

Milwaukee – The Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors unanimously confirmed the County Executive’s appointment of Supervisor Steve F. Taylor to the Eastern Wisconsin Counties Railroad Consortium for a term ending October 4, 2015.
