### **SUPERVISOR TAYLOR APPOINTED TO COMMISSION ON AGING**

*County Board confirms Taylor as newest Commissioner*

**Milwaukee, WI** – The Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors unanimously confirmed the appointment of Supervisor Steve F. Taylor, District 9, to the Milwaukee County Commission on Aging. Taylor’s service on the commission begins immediately and expires January 31, 2014.

“As an advocate for our community’s older adults, I’m honored by this appointment,” said Supervisor Taylor. “Throughout my public service, I’ve worked passionately on behalf of our aging population, and I’m eager to help to ensure that Milwaukee County addresses the needs and concerns of this population that deserves our very best.”

The Commission on Aging is a governing and policy-making body within Milwaukee County’s Department on Aging, serving as the Commission's administrative arm. The Commission on Aging currently has four standing committees and an Advisory Council.

Appointed Commissioners are responsible for developing and implementing a coordinated human service system of community-based services for Milwaukee County residents aged 60 and older.

Supervisor Taylor was elected to the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors in April 2012 to represent the 9th District, which includes Hales Corners and parts of Franklin and Oak Creek. Shortly after he was elected, Supervisor Taylor was selected by his peers to serve as 2nd Vice-Chairman of the County Board.
