Recognizing the Great Work of the Bay View Historical Society



The Bay View Historical Society has received the Wisconsin Historical Society's prestigious Reuben Gold Thwaites Trophy for the excellence of its historic educational and programming achievements. The Thwaites Trophy is awarded to a "historical society for continued excellence for its overall service to its community over a period of at least 5 years," by the Wisconsin Historical Society and is the highest award for excellence that can be granted to a historical society in the state.

Supervisor Dimitrijevic attended the group's most recent meeting on December 13th and presented a citation from Milwaukee County, recognizing the Bay View Historical Society for its efforts and achievements.

"We are so lucky to have one of the best historical societies in the State of Wisconsin. Thank you to the volunteers who remind us about the great history of our neighborhood," said Supervisor Dimitrijevic.

This will be the second time the Bay View Historical Society has earned this award. The trophy may be awarded to the same group once every 25 years. The first time was 25 years ago, and the Bay View Historical Society will be the first historical society in the state to earn the trophy a second time.

Volunteer Bell Ringer for the Salvation Army

Supervisor Dimitrijevic, a member of the Salvation Army Advisory Board, was a volunteer bell-ringer at Mayfair Mall for the red kettle collection drive. The Salvation Army is an organization which works to help the needy in our community. The red kettle donations help to accomplish this mission.

"It was chilly out there but the kindness of people's donations was heart-warming. I am happy to have played a small role in this donation drive," said Supervisor Dimitrijevic.

Hoan Bridge Update

The Wisconsin State Department of Transportation announced it would not be moving forward with a plan to install a bicycle lane on the Hoan Bridge on Friday, December 16th, 2011. "The Hoan Bridge is a vital part of the Milwaukee-area freeway system," Transportation Secretary Mark Gottlieb said. "However, the alternatives presented in the feasibility study would impair our ability to provide safe, efficient travel and deliver less value than other possible department investments in economic development in Milwaukee." Marina Honors Boy Scout Troop 11 for 100 Years of Service



Milwaukee County Supervisor Dimitrijevic recognized the scouts and leaders of Boy Scout Troop 11 for their 100th anniversary and their commitment to improving the community. Troop 11 has been an asset of Milwaukee's near south side since 1911, when scouting first came to the United States. Troop 11 has the distinction of being one of only 5 troops to reach this landmark this year. Supervisor Dimitrijevic also recognized the troop Scoutmaster, Ryan Antczak, for his guidance of the scouts in their community service projects, and teaching them the scouting values of good conduct, respect for others, and honesty. She honored the 4 Eagle Scouts from her district as well.

Exercise Equipment Installed at South Shore Park

In an effort to continue to improve opportunities for park users to exercise and work out at Milwaukee County Parks, the Department of Parks, Recreation, and Culture is in the process of installing seven Helios Multigym Units in parks throughout Milwaukee County. Following the success of the initial Helios Multigym installation along the lakefront near the Northpoint Snack Bar, the County has begun to install similar units at Cannon, Humboldt, Johnsons, King, South Shore, McCarty, and Mitchell Parks. The Northwestern Mutual Foundation has generously contributed \$40,000 towards the project.

Helios Multigyms are made to withstand Wisconsin winters, and allow users to work out on seven unique exercise stations designed into the structure:

- 45 degree back extension bench
- Abdominal crunch/sit-up bench
- Chin up bar (with chin assist function)
- Calf raise platform
- Triceps dip station (with dip assist function)
- Elevated push-up platform
- Cardio thigh squat station

Up to four people can exercise simultaneously, with all major muscle groups being targeted by providing body weight or assisted resistance training exercises.


