SUPERVISOR DIMITRIJEVIC HELPS LAUNCH THREE NEW EXPRESS BUS ROUTES *GreenLine, BlueLine to provide new express service in Bay View and Silver City neighborhoods*

Milwaukee, WI – Milwaukee County Supervisor Marina Dimitrijevic proudly participated in the launching of the Milwaukee County Transit System's (MCTS) new MetroEXpress service on Saturday.

“The GreenLine and BlueLine both run through the 4th District, and I’m glad that we are adding service to benefit transit riders and businesses, especially in the area surrounding the planned Bay View artistic bus shelter and the flourishing business area in the Silver City neighborhood,” Supervisor Dimitrijevic said. “These routes will help riders get to their destinations more quickly and efficiently.”

- The **GreenLine** serves the heart of Bay View and operates between Bayshore Town Center and General Mitchell International Airport.
- The **BlueLine**, which also travels through the 4th District, provides service along National Avenue to S. 70th/Greenfield Avenue in West Allis, and also connects downtown with the Park Place business district on the northwest side via Fond du Lac Avenue.
- The **RedLine** operates between N. 124th Street and the University of Wisconsin – Milwaukee along Capitol Drive.

“These new express routes, along with the modernization of our fleet, are exciting examples of the investments we are making in our transit system,” Supervisor Dimitrijevic added. “We’ve already taken delivery of 180 new near-zero emission buses, and, by 2014, we’ll have a total of 261 new buses, which is more than half of our fleet.”
