BUDGET AMENDMENT INCREASES PUBLIC ACCESS IN COUNTY GOVERNMENT

Finance & Audit Committee approves next phase of CLIC

Milwaukee, WI – Milwaukee County Supervisor Marina Dimitrijevic, Chair of the County Board Committee on Information Technology (Project TEAM), is thanking the Finance & Audit Committee for approving her Budget Amendment that provides funding for the final phase of the [County Legislative Information Center](#) (CLIC).

CLIC, a new service launched earlier this year, provides online access to all Milwaukee County legislation. It allows visitors to track the progress of legislative items from their introduction through adoption or rejection. County Board and Committee meetings are all now CLIC-able, but the final phase will provide, for the first time, live and archived online video from all County Board and Committee meetings.

“I’m excited about the opportunity to move forward with phase 2 of CLIC, and I encourage the full Board to approve this amendment on budget adoption day,” Supervisor Dimitrijevic said. “I’d like to thank Supervisors Jason Haas, Eyon Biddle, Sr., Nikiya Harris, Theodore Lipscomb, Sr., and Gerry Broderick for co-sponsoring this budget amendment.”

Project TEAM (Technology, Efficiency, Accessibility, and Modernization), aims to increase public access to County government through the use of technology.

“CLIC would not have been possible without Board Chairman Lee Holloway, my colleagues on the County Board, Board Staff, and County Clerk Czarnezki. They have supported this project every step of the way,” Supervisor Dimitrijevic added. “This next phase will make Milwaukee County more transparent and accountable to the constituents we serve.”
