PARKS INFRASTRUCTURE NEEDS SHOULD NOT BE DELAYED

Milwaukee, WI – Milwaukee County Supervisor Marina Dimitrijevic released the following statement after the County Board voted to lay over a five-year plan on parks infrastructure improvements:

“Today’s County Board vote to lay over this five-year plan for the future of the Milwaukee County Parks system is extremely disappointing. For years, deferred maintenance needs have persisted in our parks. The detailed report from the Department of Audit provides a clear road map on how to move our parks forward. I especially support the innovative investments proposed for new, public revenue-generating endeavors within the Parks Department. It also includes funding for the relocation of South Shore Beach, which would allow this great resource to flourish in the 4th district which I represent.”
