SUPERVISOR DIMITRIJEVIC TO SPEAK AT 8th ANNUAL MATC GREEN VEHICLES WORKSHOP

Milwaukee, WI – Milwaukee County Supervisor Marina Dimitrijevic will speak at the “Driving Toward 2020 Green Vehicles Workshop” at the Milwaukee Area Technical College on Friday. The workshop will showcase energy-efficient and diminished-emission vehicles for the present and near future.

“Promoting fuel efficient vehicles and alternative fuels results in cleaner air and greater energy independence,” Supervisor Dimitrijevic added. “Milwaukee County has already received \$120,000 in Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant federal stimulus funds to help purchase clean vehicles for our fleet, including vehicles used by the Parks Department.”

Supervisor Dimitrijevic also plans to discuss her “Green Print” legislation, which is raising environmental and conservation standards within Milwaukee County and preserving resources for future generations. “I’m excited to participate in this workshop to detail Milwaukee County’s goals in enacting the Green Print. We have already achieved a number of milestones since the Green Print was signed in 2007,” Supervisor Dimitrijevic said. “A key provision within the Green Print is the purchase of hybrids and other vehicles powered by alternative fuels.”
