**MILWAUKEE COUNTY BOARD CHAIRWOMAN TO HOLD LISTENING SESSION
AT PULASKI INDOOR POOL “DOLLAR DAYS” EVENT**

**Dollar Days to be Held March 5, 11 and 22;
Dimitrijevic to Hold Listening Session at the Indoor Pool at 1 p.m. on March 22**

Milwaukee County Board Chairwoman Marina Dimitrijevic will hold an informal listening session at a “dollar days” event at Pulaski Indoor Pool, 2701 S. 16th St., on Sunday, March 22 from 1 p.m. to 2 p.m.

“Bring your friends and family for a dollar days swim,” Dimitrijevic said. “I’ll be there to welcome you and listen to your concerns about our neighborhood. Come check out this great resource in our neighborhood.”

Sponsored by Milwaukee County Parks, dollar days at Pulaski Indoor Pool will be held Thursday, March 5 from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m.; Wednesday, March 11 from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. and Sunday, March 22, from 12 p.m. to 5 p.m. Dimitrijevic will be at the Sunday, March 22 session from 1 p.m. to 2 p.m.

County Executives have proposed closing pools, and Dimitrijevic has led successful efforts to restore funding to keep the Pulaski and Noyes Park pools open. In 2013, Stan Kass also donated \$100,000 towards the pools remaining open.

“Pulaski indoor pool is an invaluable resource in our community,” Dimitrijevic said. “That’s why I fought so hard to keep it open. It is a great place for recreation, especially during the long winter months. But it’s not enough just to keep the doors open. It is our responsibility to let the community know that the pools are open and that everyone is welcome.

“I look forward to hearing from pool users and residents of my district at Pulaski indoor pool on March 22.”
