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CHAIRWOMAN DIMITRIJEVIC ANNOUNCES LEADERSHIP TEAM

Milwaukee, WI – Milwaukee County Board Chairwoman Marina Dimitrijevic is pleased to announce details on her leadership team for the upcoming term.

Pending approval by the full County Board, the Committee process will be streamlined by combining the Finance & Audit Committee and the Personnel Committee into one nine-member Committee led by two Co-Chairs, Supervisors Willie Johnson, Jr., and David Cullen. A majority of Supervisors are co-sponsoring the proposed Ordinance change.

“The Finance & Personnel Committee that will be proposed is a hybrid approach that incorporates best practices already used by Legislative branches in the City of Milwaukee and the State of Wisconsin,” Chairwoman Dimitrijevic said. “My colleagues on the County Board will consider this change to the County Board committee structure. This common sense change will allow for a quicker, cleaner process.”
