County residents are provided an opportunity to weigh in on restructuring governance

Milwaukee, WI – Milwaukee County Supervisor Patricia Jursik invites County residents to a public meeting about the future of County governance:

State Representative Joseph Sanfelippo will present his bill for restructuring County government. County Supervisor Theo Lipscomb, Chair of the County Board's Committee on Intergovernmental Relations, will respond with a counterpoint argument from the local Board perspective. Supervisor Jursik will also review County services from a governance perspective.

Supervisor Jursik hopes that her constituents learn and comment about the options to restructure County governance.

“As your representative on the County Board, I have not yet taken a position with regard to this restructuring,” said Supervisor Jursik. “In order to take a position, I am holding a public meeting to both inform and to obtain your input. I look forward to hearing your questions and comments.”

“What do you want from your local County government? I am hopeful that my constituents will fill the auditorium to discuss this important issue.”

Milwaukee County Supervisor Patricia Jursik represents the South Shore communities of St. Francis, Cudahy, South Milwaukee and a portion of Oak Creek. She has championed long-range strategic planning to downsize surplus County facilities; to redesign human resources, employee benefits and financial planning; and to plan for a sustainable Milwaukee County.
