THE SOUTH SHORE OPTION 2.0: FORUM FOR ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

Milwaukee, WI – For the second year, Milwaukee County Supervisor Patricia Jursik along with the mayors of the South Shore communities – Oak Creek Mayor Steve Scaffidi, South Milwaukee Mayor Thomas Zepecki, Cudahy Mayor Tony Day and St. Francis Mayor CoryAnn St.Marie-Carls – are co-sponsoring a unique, one-stop forum for constituents and the development community to hear from economic development staff and the Community Development Authorities (CDAs) of each city regarding economic development planning throughout the South Shore. The forum will also include Ted Torcivia, Airport Business Manager representing the new MKE Regional Business Park.

Supervisor Jursik has stated that she is bullish on the South Shore. This forum will highlight the dynamic plans formulated by the CDAs with the leadership of their City Councils and Mayors. Jursik will provide updates on the Hoan Bridge, Lake Parkway (794) extension planning, the Aerotropolis initiative and the outlook for public transit. The new MKE Regional Business Park will also be introduced. Additionally, each agency will staff booths displaying aerial maps, mock-ups, elevations and planning materials of current or upcoming projects for public viewing and inquiries in an open-house setting. Information about the concept of Tax Incremental Financing will also be available.

“This forum is again a rare opportunity for citizens to be a part of planning for multi-community development in one meeting and to learn about efforts toward economic growth in our South Shore communities,” said Supervisor Jursik. “I would like to thank Mayor Steve Scaffidi and the Oak Creek Police Department for hosting The South Shore Option 2.0 this year.”
