The Bus User Safety at Southridge (BUSS) Coalition will conduct an Easter Promenade on the North Sidewalk outside the Southridge Shopping Mall. This Easter Parade will remind Milwaukee shoppers that Milwaukee County citizens hold dear to their values of caring for the elderly, physically impaired and disabled veterans.
