REDISTRICTING COMMITTEE TO HOLD SECOND PUBLIC HEARING FRIDAY

Milwaukee, WI – County Supervisor Michael Mayo, Sr., Chairman of the County Board’s Redistricting Committee, is inviting all interested Milwaukee County residents to attend a Public Hearing on redistricting this Friday. The County is required to adjust districts based on results from the 2010 U.S. Census.

“Milwaukee County is continuing the process of changing its Supervisory Districts in an open and transparent manner,” Supervisor Mayo added. “This Public Hearing during the evening gives residents the opportunity to testify in front of the Committee and make their opinions known.”

Residents will be strictly limited to three minutes of testimony each. Written testimony of any length can also be submitted to the Committee.

In addition to hearing from constituents who attend the Public Hearing, Supervisors will also conduct Committee business. Possible redistricting plans could also be considered at the meeting.
