REDISTRICTING COMMITTEE TO HOLD THIRD PUBLIC HEARING

Milwaukee, WI – County Supervisor Michael Mayo, Sr., Chairman of the County Board’s Redistricting Committee, is inviting all interested Milwaukee County residents to attend a Public Hearing on redistricting Wednesday. The County is required to adjust districts based on results from the 2010 U.S. Census.

“Milwaukee County is continuing the process of changing its Supervisory Districts in an open and transparent manner,” Supervisor Mayo added. “More than three months have passed since the Committee’s first public hearing. Public hearings were previously held on April 6 and April 15. This third Public Hearing gives residents another opportunity to testify in front of the Committee and make their opinions known.”

Residents may be limited to three minutes of testimony each, depending on the number of individuals who wish to testify. Written testimony of any length can also be submitted to the Committee.

In addition to hearing from constituents who attend the Public Hearing, Supervisors may also submit proposed redistricting plans. **No action will be taken on any redistricting plans at this meeting.**
