

# Schedule of Public Hearings on the 2011 County Budget

Starting Friday, October 8, the Finance & Audit Committee of the Milwaukee County Board of Supervisors will hold further public hearings about the items to be considered for inclusion in the 2011 County Budget. Each hearing deals with a specific part of the budget – parks, the courts, transit, behavioral health, etc. – so people will know which day(s) to come and testify.

The hearings will be held at the County Courthouse in Room 203-R, a large committee room. If you come with neighbors or as part of a group, all may speak, or designate one or two to speak and have the rest stand to show they agree with you. Plan to arrive early enough to allow for any delay in finding parking and coming through the security checkpoint.
