SUPERVISOR ROMO WEST ANNOUNCES WORKSHOP FOR IMMIGRANT YOUTH

Voces de la Frontera Youth Branch Offers Help with Documentation, Sunday, August 19

Milwaukee, WI – Supervisor Peggy Romo West is set to volunteer at the DREAMer Application Drive, hosted by Youth Empowered in the Struggle, the youth branch of Voces de la Frontera, on Sunday, August 19, 2012 at 2 p.m. at St. Adalbert’s church basement at 1923 W. Beecher Street in Milwaukee.

Workshop organizers will teach immigrant youth how to fill out residency applications; lawyers will answer questions; and volunteers will help youth ensure they have prepared all necessary documentation.

“It’s my privilege to get involved and to help protect our youth in Milwaukee County from deportation,” said Supervisor Romo West. “These are children and teenagers who were born here or who have lived here for at least five years, and they’re looking to become contributing members of our communities, County, state and country.”

Youth should bring documents that show they entered and remained in the United States from at least June 15, 2007 through June 15, 2012. Such documents include birth certificates and passports as well as financial, school records, medical, employment or military records.
