SUPERVISOR ROMO WEST REMEMBERS JUSTIN “JJ” KOHEN Asks Public’s Assistance in Apprehending His Murderer

Milwaukee – Milwaukee County Supervisor Peggy Romo West, District 12, will host a series of events to celebrate the life of Justin “JJ” Kohen. Justin, 28, who was attacked on April 3rd, 2012 while leaving his home in the 2200 block of South 16th Street on Milwaukee’s South Side. He died six days later as a result of stab wounds.

“I am saddened by the senseless violence that took JJ’s life,” said Supervisor Romo West. “We should all be very concerned that the individuals responsible for Justin’s death remain at large, so on the first anniversary of JJ’s death, I join the Kohen Family in asking the public’s assistance in providing information leading to the arrest of these individuals.”
