SUPERVISORS TO PARTICIPATE IN FEED THE KIDS KICKOFF EVENT

Milwaukee, WI – Milwaukee County Supervisors Peggy A. Romo West, Deanna Alexander, and Russell W. Stamper II will be on hand for the Salvation Army's Feed the Kids event today.

“The nutritional care of the children in the Greater Milwaukee area is extremely important,” Supervisor Romo West said. “Last year, Kosciuszko Park, which is located in the 12th District, had the highest usage of this program in the City of Milwaukee.”

For the 23rd year in a row, the Salvation Army's Mobile Lunch Program provides lunches each weekday for children throughout Milwaukee during the summer when school is out. The program has provided more than 1.5 million lunches to needy children since it began in 1990. Nearly 100,000 lunches were provided last year.
