Applying is easy.

What to Bring:

1. Photo ID (recommended; mandatory for 1st time applicants)
2. Social Security numbers and dates of birth for each household occupant
3. Current gas, electric or oil energy bill (or lease/letter from your landlord if heat is included in your rent)
4. Proof of all income sources for the entire household's gross income for the 3 months prior to application (child support, wages, pension, unemployment, etc.) Seasonal employees will require the prior year's entire tax package.
