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**MILWAUKEE COUNTY EMS  
ADMINISTRATIVE POLICY  
INVENTORY AND SUPPLIES**

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**POLICY:** Municipalities will comply with policies and procedures related to ordering pharmaceuticals, equipment and supplies for the delivery of patient care services as established by Milwaukee County.

Milwaukee County may procure and provide non-disposable equipment to the municipalities. This equipment will remain the property of Milwaukee County. The equipment may be removed by Milwaukee County upon notification of the municipality.

Milwaukee County will obtain all consumable medical supplies for patient care on all paramedic transport vehicles. Medications and supplies shall be standard medications and supplies authorized in the program.

Equipment, supplies and/or commodities for the defibrillator(s), radio(s), phone(s), and glucose monitor(s) owned by the Milwaukee County must be ordered through the County's program.

All pharmaceuticals must be ordered through Milwaukee County's program.

Other equipment and supplies may be ordered by the Municipality from alternative sources but are required to be standard equipment and supplies authorized in the program. Substitutions by another supplier will not be acceptable.

Milwaukee County will provide a list of equipment and supplies that must be ordered through County.

Milwaukee County will be reimbursed for costs associated with the procurement of medical supplies and/or commodities ordered on behalf of the municipality. The reimbursement for these medical supplies and/or commodities will be obtained as a reduction in the monthly payment to the Municipality.
