FULL CLOSURE OF GLENVIEW SLATED FOR WEEK OF JULY 8, 2013

As part of the Zoo Interchange project, the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) will be making improvements to 84th Street/Glenview Avenue. Construction has begun, and will be completed in August 2013.

Glenview Avenue, from Bluemound Road to just north of Wisconsin Avenue, will be reconstructed to include two through lanes and a shared center turn lane. **Beginning the week of July 8th, Glenview Avenue, between Bluemound Road and Wisconsin Avenue, will be closed for two months with local access only to residents, businesses and schools within the closure.** Work will also include **a full closure of the intersection of Glenview Avenue and Wisconsin Avenue for approximately one month.** Access to businesses and residents will be maintained during construction.

The project team appreciates your patience during this period of intense construction in your neighborhood.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

Some construction activities are likely to create noise and/or dust, and some work may be conducted at night during the course of the project. Be assured that we always work hard to minimize the impact of these events, but, if you have a concern, please do not hesitate to contact us so that we can address the issue immediately.

RESIDENT REMINDERS

- 48 hour notice will be provided for any driveway impacts
- On-street parking permits have been supplied to those whose driveways will be affected
- Bus stops will be relocated as they are influenced by construction
- Garbage collection will be coordinated with the City of Wauwatosa
- Personal property such as sprinklers, piping, fencing, garden décor and the like should be removed from the right of way / easements
- The contractor is required to submit and implement a dust control plan during the work
- Safety of the public and workers is paramount
