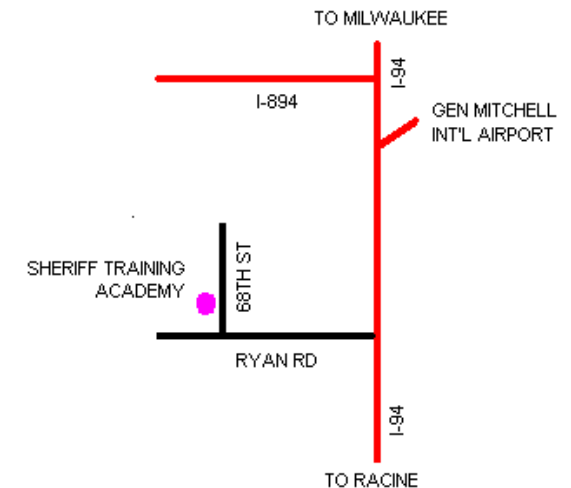
Your Instructors
