2011 KEY CARD MEMBERSHIP

Teens ages 16 and older and adults with disabilities are required to become a Key Card Member to register for our programs. Ask us about all the other benefits of being a Key Card Member. Application is located as an insert. Please note key card membership is good for the calendar year from January 1st to December 31st and must be renewed each year.

TRANSPORTATION

Participants are responsible for their own transportation arrangements. Easter Seals staff will ONLY be present during the scheduled program times listed in the program guide. Participants should plan to arrive NO EARLIER THAN 15 MINUTES prior to starting time of any programs or dances. In the case of participants arriving earlier than 15 minutes prior to the scheduled start time of the program they will have to wait until staff arrive. Please make rides with Transit accordingly.

INCLEMENT WEATHER

Please look for WIL-O-WAY RECREATION CENTER or EASTER SEALS RECREATION CENTER on TMJ 4 or News Radio 620 WTMJ and 94.5 WWTI for any closing or cancellations due to inclement weather. This applies to programs and special events held at Holler Park and community locations such as bowling alleys.
