## 2011 KEY CARD MEMBERSHIP

Teens ages 16 and older and adults with disabilities are required to become a Key Card Member to register for our programs. Ask us about all the other benefits of being a Key Card Member. Application is located on page 8. Please note key card membership is good for the calendar year from January 1st to December 31st and must be renewed each year.

## TRANSPORTATION

Participants are responsible for their own transportation arrangements. Easter Seals staff will ONLY be present during the scheduled program times listed in the program guide. Participants should plan to arrive NO EARLIER THAN 15 MINUTES prior to starting time of any programs or dances.

## INCLEMENT WEATHER

## PARTICIPANT GRIEVANCE PROCEDURE

This complaint resolution process is designed to provide you with easy access to the correct contacts. A participant, guardian, ward, family member, caregiver or other interested party may report a complaint about services provided by Easter Seals Southeast Wisconsin, Inc. within 45 days of the occurrence. The complaint may be expressed verbally, in writing, or by any alternative method through which the individual ordinarily communicates. You will not be discriminated against or threatened in any way for reporting a complaint. Whenever possible you should first attempt to resolve a complaint with the program staff involved.

## PROGRAM REGISTRATION

## REGISTRATION DETAILS

  - \*If you are not able to pay the entire amount of your fee in advance, please call to discuss a payment plan.
- All payments must be received with registration.

## CREDITS/REFUNDS

Due to the nature of our programs and outings in which tickets or supplies must be purchased in advance, there will be NO refunds or credits given if you are not able to attend. If a program is cancelled by Easter Seals or your program is full, you will receive a CREDIT towards another program.

## 2011 KEY CARD MEMBERSHIP
