2013 KEY CARD MEMBERSHIP

Teens ages 16 and older and adults with disabilities are required to become a Key Card Member to register for our programs. The only exception is the Friday Night Dances where you can pay the non-member fee. Ask us about all the other benefits of being a Key Card Member. Application is located in the center of this book as an insert. Please note key card membership is good for the calendar year from January 1st to December 31st and must be renewed each year.

Please note that Key Card Memberships are processed by Milwaukee County Office for Persons with Disabilities and are to be mailed to their offices – not to Easter Seals Southeast Wisconsin. More detailed instructions are located on the Key Card Application.

TRANSPORTATION

Participants are responsible for their own transportation arrangements. Easter Seals staff will ONLY be present during the scheduled program times listed in the program guide. Participants should plan to arrive NO EARLIER THAN 15 MINUTES prior to starting time of any programs or dances.

INCLEMENT WEATHER

Please look for WIL-O-WAY RECREATION CENTER or EASTER SEALS RECREATION CENTER on TMJ 4 or News Radio 620 WTMJ and 94.5 WKTJ for any closing or cancellations due to inclement weather. This applies to programs and special events held at community locations such as bowling alleys.

PARTICIPANT GRIEVANCE PROCEDURE

You will not be discriminated against or threatened in any way for reporting a complaint. Whenever possible you should first attempt to resolve a complaint with the program staff involved.
