BUS STOP BARRIER BUSTERS ADVANCE EFFORTS IN 2014

With fall in full bloom, temperatures and leaves are falling and soon enough, snow flurries will pile up! Do slushy barriers cause you havoc, essentially icing any attempt at traversing to your Thanksgiving feast? Have no fear, the barrier buster is here! Milwaukee County Transit System (MCTS) and the Transit Plus' New Freedom staff are pleased to let you know that the 2014 barrier removal program has had a very successful year, with **84** new ADA-compliant bus pads and two shelters already in place, and a few more expected to be installed before the freeze.

In October, the expert crews from the Milwaukee County Highway Department completed 13 new stops in



Wauwatosa, which has some of the city's most popular destinations and highest ADA boarding locations. Specifically, new pads were installed at three bus stops along Route 31 on Milwaukee and Harwood Avenues, as well as three pads on 76th Street along

Route 67. Nine new pads were constructed on West North Avenue from Mayfair Mall to 124th Street for Routes 21 and 28, as well as two pads on Mayfair Road in front of the mall, improving access to the multitude of popular destinations nearby.

The other area of focus for the buster team was on Congress Street, on Milwaukee's northwest side, which boasts some of the highest concentrations of non-ADA compliant bus stops in the city. Nine beautiful new pads were installed from Appleton Avenue, west to 92nd Street for Route 23, as well as one frequent rider requested pad improvement on 76th Street and Fiebrantz Avenue for Route 67. If you are someone who frequents Columbia St. Mary's Hospital on North and Prospect Avenues, you

will be pleased to know that the westbound Route 21 shelter has been reinstalled to protect you from the brutal, unpredictable Wisconsin weather!

The barrier buster will follow up its work by heading to the City of South Milwaukee to improve eleven bus pads along 15th Avenue. The new pads will improve access to South Milwaukee High School, Middle School and the

Performing Arts Center. Another area of interest is the neighborhood around Mitchell International Airport. The intersection of Howell and Layton Avenue is the main priority, with three of the four island landing pads needing drastic accessibility improvements. Thirteen pads are planned to be installed on Howell and Edgerton Avenues, as well as 6th Street for Route 80 and the Green Line. But wait, there's more! Two additional bus shelters are also planned to be installed this year, one is to be reinstalled at the southeast corner of 27th Street and National where one was removed last year, and the other will be a brand new shelter in front of the new Goodwill office building in Greendale along Route 64 on 60th

Street and Greenway.

With the impending snow season rapidly approaching, MCTS gives a friendly reminder and encourages all riders and residents to spread the word on the importance of snow removal at bus stops, as well as sidewalks and curb ramps. Keeping the ice and snow clear is crucial to people who have difficulty with mobility, as well as strollers and carts. The lack of a cleared path can prevent someone from even leaving their home, so remember to shovel and salt!!

In 2014, our goal is to surpass the 45 bus pads installed in 2013, improving accessibility to all MCTS passengers. As always, the New Freedom team highly encourages riders to let us know of any non-accessible stops on any routes; we appreciate your comments. 

COUNTY EXECUTIVE INTERNSHIP PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

Purpose: It is the purpose of this program to provide meaningful educational opportunities for undergraduate and graduate level students within the Executive Office of Milwaukee County Government while providing support to full-time staff.



Requirements: Students should be enrolled full-time or part-time in an undergraduate or higher program. Preference will be given students whose field relates directly to the activities of the County Executive's Office. These may include, but are not limited to, fields such as political science, public administration, economic development, urban studies, journalism, public relations, and communications.

Ideal applicants should exhibit the following qualities:

- strong written and verbal communication skills
- a calm and positive attitude in the face of difficult situations
- a commitment to public service
- strong work ethic
- the ability to work independently on tasks

Students should be able to devote 10-15 hours per week to their internship.

All internships with the office of the County Executive are unpaid. Students may perform the internship for credit provided that any assignments pertaining to the office are approved by staff before submission to the school.

Activities of Interns: Interns will work alongside the full-time staff of the Executive Office. Interns may be involved in some or all of the following: constituent service issues, research pertaining to issues being discussed by the Executive's office and the County Board, drafting of Executive Proclamations, responding to scheduling requests, and creating briefings/talking points for the County Executive. Interns will also have the option to attend staff meetings as an opportunity to learn about County government.
