#### CONSIDER YOUR OPTIONS FOR PUBLICLY-FUNDED LONG-TERM CARE

As a Medicaid-eligible resident of Milwaukee County, you may be able to choose among the following programs to meet your long-term care and health care needs:

- Family Care covers your long-term care services, but your primary care (e.g. doctor's visits and check-ups) and acute care (emergency care and hospitalization) will be covered separately by Medicare and/or Medicaid.
- Partnership uses Medicare and Medicaid to coordinate and cover your long-term, primary, and acute care along with pharmacy services.
- Program for All-Inclusive Care for the Elderly
  (PACE) is available for persons age 55 and older.
  It uses Medicare and Medicaid to coordinate
  and cover your long-term, primary, and acute
  care along with pharmacy services. Some of the
  services may be provided at the PACE Day Center
  if you choose to attend.
- Include, Respect, I Self-Direct (IRIS) is the self-directed supports program covering long-term care needs that you decide are most important for you. Some long-term care needs, along with your acute and primary care needs, will be covered by Medicare and/or Medicaid.

**Or, you can** use your **Medicaid (Title 19) Forward Card** to cover doctor visits and other health services.


