MILWAUKEE RIVER

- 1. **Brown Deer Road** Meet at the intersection Upper River Rd and Brown Deer Rd. Paddle from Brown Deer Rd. to Kletzsch Park while picking up trash. **NOTE: Canoe needed, must preregister for this site.** (8800 N Upper River Rd. / River Hills)
- 2. **Estabrook Park** Meet at the parking lot by picnic area #6. (4400 N. Estabrook PWKY. / Milwaukee)
- 3. **Gordon Park** Meet at the parking lot by the pavilion building. (1321 E. Locust St. / Milwaukee)
- 4. **Kern Park** –Park on the street along Humboldt Blvd or Singer Circle then walk toward the center of the park and down the hill. Meet at the tree line of the bluff on the river. (3614 N. Humboldt Blvd. / Milwaukee)
- 5. **Kletzsch Park** Meet at the pavilion on the east side of the Parkway (6560 N. Milwaukee River Pkwy. / Glendale)
- 6. **Lincoln Creek** Meet at the Estabrook Church west parking lot. (5385 N. Green Bay Ave. / Milwaukee)
- 7. **Riverside Park** Meet at playground by Riverside Park sign off Oakland Ave. (1400 E. Riverside Place / Milwaukee)

MENOMONEE RIVER

- 8. **Honey Creek** –Meet at the CH2M Hill parking lot off of I-94/84th St exit in the Honey Creek Corporate Center. (135 S. 84th St. / Milwaukee)
- 9. **Hoyt Park/Hansen Park** Meet at picnic area #3 by the Hoyt Park Swimming Pool parking lot, located along the Menomonee River Parkway where Hoyt Dr. intersects the Parkway. (1800 Swan Blvd. / Wauwatosa)
- 10. **Jacobus Park** Meet behind the pavilion near the flag pole, just off of 68th St. (6500 W. Hillside Ln. / Wauwatosa)
- 11. **Little Menomonee River Parkway** Meet at the intersection of 91st St. and Good Hope Rd, across the street from Walgreens. Parking is available at Vincent High School on Granville Rd and Calumet Rd. (9040 W. Good Hope Rd. / Milwaukee)
- 12. **Menomonee River Pkwy/Burleigh St** Meet at the intersection of Menomonee River Pkwy & Burleigh St. (3000 N. Menomonee River Pkwy. / Milwaukee)
- 13. **Menomonee River Pkwy/North Ave.** Meet at the intersection of Menomonee River Pkwy and North Ave. (2300 N. Menomonee River Pkwy. / Wauwatosa)
- 14. **Underwood Creek Parkway** Meet at the southeast parking lot near the intersection of 115th St. and Watertown Plank Rd. (1160 N. 115th St. / Wauwatosa)

KINNICKINNIC RIVER

- 15. Holler Park (Saturday, April 28th) Meet in the Holler Park parking lot. (5160 S. 6th St. / Milwaukee)
- 16. **Jackson Park** Meet at the boathouse. (3500 W. Forest Home Ave. / Milwaukee)
