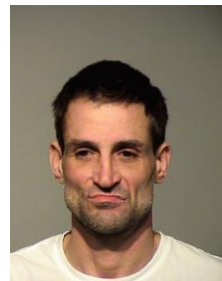
Operation Drive Sober Results in 9 Arrests 1718 Repeat Offenders Since January 2010

Milwaukee, WI – Sheriff David A. Clarke Jr. has ordered a continued aggressive weekend Driving Under the Influence (DUI) initiative to rid the Milwaukee County freeway system of drunken drivers. This weekend's initiative from Friday through Sunday resulted in the arrest of nine (9) drunken drivers. The average PBT result was .16.

Two repeat offenders were taken into custody for DUI-3rd: Justin Dobbe, age 26, of West Allis, and Stephen Cole, age 44, of Oak Creek.

One of the DUI -1st offenders faces additional charges. On Saturday night, April 1, 2017, at about 2:22 a.m., Juan Marguia, age 39, of Milwaukee, was involved in a crash on the north to east ramp in the Marquette Interchange. Marguia crashed into a median barrier wall and no other vehicles were involved in the crash. The crash investigation revealed that Marguia had been driving the wrong way on the freeway prior to the crash. A passenger in Marguia's vehicle suffered non-life-threatening injuries. Marguia also suffered non-life-threatening injuries and both were transported to a local hospital for medical treatment. Marguia stated that he drank "4, 5, 6 Modelo beers" and that he had been drinking downtown. He faces an additional charge of Reckless Endangering Safety 2 degree, which is a felony.

Other first time offenders were: Jimmy Moffet, age 25, of Milwaukee, Jose Naranjo De Leon, age 28, of Milwaukee, Luis Cruz, age 42, of Milwaukee, Taylor Briglevic, age 19, of East Troy, Jimmy Yang, age 19, of Oak Creek, and Samantha Szymakowski, age 24, of Franklin.
