Violence	Medical	Sexual	Definitions
<p>Threat of Harm to Others</p> <p>Threat to cause harm to others</p>	<p>Physical Injury</p> <p>Trauma or injury due to a physical impact or accident that did not occur at placement.</p>	<p>Pregnancy</p> <p>Confirmed or alleged pregnancy of youth or youth alleged to be a father. Also at the outcome of the pregnancy (i.e. delivery)</p>	
<p>Physical Contact</p> <p>An act of fighting or hitting someone, but does not result in bodily harm</p>	<p>Death</p> <p>Death of someone who had a direct connection with youth.</p>		
<p>Seriously Escalating Behavior</p> <p>Behaviors that appear to be increasing in intensity. Actions that could result in misdemeanor charges but have not (i.e. tearing up the classroom, breaking window)</p>	<p>Medical Emergency</p> <p>A medical emergency that resulted in 911 being called or treated in an emergency room.</p>
