## Children, Youth & Family Services (CYFS)

Programming is voluntary and assessments are done at no-cost to the family. Options Counselors will work with the family to determine if the youth meets the enrollment criteria for the following programs: **Birth to 3, Children's Long Term Support (CLTS), Children's Community Options Program (CCOP)**, or offer resources for support and services within the community.

## Children, Youth & Family Services (CYFS)

**Birth to 3** is an early intervention program designed to support families of young children, under the age of 3 with developmental delays or disabilities.

**Children's Community Options Program (CCOP)** supports children and youth who live at home or in the community, have substantial limitations in multiple daily activities because of one or more of the following needs: developmental, physical, or mental health.

**Children's Long Term Support Waiver Program (CLTS)** works to support individual choice, enhance relationships, build accessibility, and offers flexible service systems. CLTS supports youth in achieving optimum physical and mental health by promoting presence, participation, optimal social functioning, and inclusion in the community. CLTS requires Medicaid Eligibility.
