

Milwaukee County-Behavioral Health Services: Wraparound Milwaukee - Children's Community Mental Health Services System of Care

Reaching, Engaging, and Assisting Children and Families (REACH)

REACH serves youth who are experiencing a psychiatric crisis or if intervention is not provided, are at risk of experiencing a psychiatric crisis. The purpose of REACH is to assist with conflict management to prevent out-of-home placement, improve the youth's coping skills to reduce risk of harm to self or others, and assist in obtaining supportive services in the community.

Comprehensive Community Services (CCS)

Serves Milwaukee County youth, young adults, and their families who are coping with mental health/substance abuse concerns



Coordinated Opportunities for Recovery & Empowerment (CORE)

Specialized Mental Health Services for youth experiencing their first episode psychosis or at clinical high risk for psychosis. Youth must be eligible for CCS.

Lifting Youth and Families through Empowerment (LYFE)

Specialized Mental Health Services for youth experiencing high acuity needs, such as suicidal ideation and self-harming. Combines both CCS and Crisis services.

Supporting Holistic Interventions for Needs and Empowerment (SHINE)

Supports youth living with a complex mental health diagnosis and co-occurring intellectual or developmental needs contributing to higher emotional distress. Works with youth who are in CCS and CLTS.

Dual CCS/CLTS Care Coordination

Supports youth who are in both CCS and CLTS to have one Care Coordinator supporting both CCS and CLTS needs.

Owen's Place

A community drop-in Resource Center for young adults whose mental health needs may have an impact on their independence. Youth advocacy and leadership skill development for youth to make a difference in the community

Trauma Response Team (TRT)

In collaboration with MPD, support services are provided for children & families affected by violent trauma

MKE Mobile Crisis

Crisis services for youth & families of Milwaukee County

Youth Crisis Stabilization Facility (YCSF)

Facility available to girls, 17 years old and younger, who are experiencing a mental health crisis

Technical Assistance offered to Wraparound and other Mental Health programs that includes: training, workforce and leadership development, program development, QA/QI, sustainable funding models, and System of Care expansion

Milwaukee County Mental Health Clinic

Provides medication management and wellness/education services

Milwaukee County-Behavioral Health Services: Wraparound Milwaukee - Children's Community Mental Health Services System of Care

Wraparound Milwaukee - Children's Community Mental Health Services is the Behavioral Health Service's entity that manages the public sector, community-based mental health system for youth (ages 5-23) in Milwaukee County who have serious mental health or emotional needs. Serving as the umbrella body for a number of programs, all programs rely on care coordination, offer a range of support services, and promote parental and youth choice, family independence, and provide trauma informed care for youth in the context of their family and community.

Reaching, Engaging and Assisting Children & Families (REACH) – Serves youth who are experiencing a psychiatric crisis or if intervention is not provided, are at risk of experiencing a psychiatric crisis. The purpose is to assist with conflict management to prevent out-of-home placement, improve the youth's coping skills to reduce risk of harm to self or others, and assist in obtaining supportive services in the community. A Care Coordinator will assist with developing a crisis plan and connecting to supports and services within the community or the youth's insurance. Enrollment into REACH may include crisis stabilization and some time-limited specialized services.

Comprehensive Community Services (CCS) – An option which provides support and services to youth and young adults who are coping with either a mental health and/or substance abuse diagnosis. CCS addresses needs throughout a person's lifespan, with a coordinated and comprehensive array of recovery, treatment and psychosocial rehabilitation services.

Coordinated Opportunities for Recovery and Empowerment (CORE)– Funded by CCS, serves 10-23 year olds who are clinically high risk for psychosis, or who are experiencing their first episode with psychosis. Services included: Care Coordination, Individual Therapy, Employment and Education Support, Peer Support and Medication Management.

Lifting Youth and Families Through Empowerment (LYFE) - Provides behavioral support services to youth who are experiencing high acuity needs, such as suicidal ideation, self-harming, or other mental health related-behaviors that may require more long-term crisis-based support. LYFE combines both CCS and Crisis-based services in order to support the youth and they must be eligible for both. Services may include: Care Coordination, DBT Therapy, Peer Support, and Crisis Stabilization.

Supporting Holistic Interventions for Needs and Empowerment (SHINE) - Supports youth living with a complex mental health diagnosis and co-occurring intellectual or developmental needs contributing to higher emotional distress. Youth in this program must be eligible for CCS and Children's Long-term Support (CLTS). Services may include: Care Coordination, Therapy, Occupational Therapy, and Parent Peer Support.

Provider Network & Community Resources – Wraparound Milwaukee - Children's Community Mental Health Services has a broad benefit plan of over 100 different mental health, social and supportive services. This network of community agencies and individual providers provides a variety of options for every service type, giving families considerable choice for their child and their family. Services may include psychiatry, therapy, crisis stabilization, professional foster parent, skill development, and resources available in the community.

Owen's Place – A community drop-in resource center for young adults ages 16- 24 whose mental health needs may be impacting their ability to become independent. Empowering young adults to advocate for themselves around causes that are important to them and their respective community. Please visit us at our two locations:

Trauma Response Team (TRT) – In collaboration with the Milwaukee Police Department, provides support to youth & their families when they have witnessed or have been exposed to potentially traumatic events such as serious accidents, sudden death, shootings, violence, or domestic violence.

MKE Mobile Crisis – Provides 24/7 crisis intervention services to any family in Milwaukee County with a child who is experiencing a mental health emergency in which the behavior of the child threatens their removal from home, a community placement, and/or school.

Youth Crisis Stabilization Facility (YCSF) - During their short-term stay, youth will receive therapeutic services, recreation, life skills support, and transitional case management.

Milwaukee County Mental Health Clinic – Provides medication management and overall wellness care and education for the mental and physical health of youth in the Wraparound Milwaukee System of Care.
