Contract Description: A. Work of the Project includes constructing a 10-foot-wide asphalt access ramp connection with 3-foot shoulders between the intersection of N Cambridge Ave and E Kenwood Blvd and the existing Oak Leaf Trail. Specific project work includes grading operations, base aggregate dense, retaining wall installation, ADA curb ramps at the roadway intersection, permanent signing, pavement marking, and slope restoration.

Substantial Completion Date: June 30th, 2027.

Prime contractor shall perform at least 30 percent of the original contract amount with contractor's own organization per section 108.1.2 of the current edition of the WisDOT standard specifications for highway and structure construction. See Project Manual Invitation to Bid.

Specifications and contract documents also known as special provisions are federal, state, or industry-recognized standard specifications and do not conflict with federal laws/regulations. All contract language references the WisDOT Standard Specifications General Requirements and Covenants (Part 1).

Contractor shall complete the Affidavit of Non-Collusion that is part of the Bid Form confirming that the bidder has not engaged in any collusion related to the bidding of the project.
