Work consists of reconstructing the circular drive at the boathouse (Segment 03) and the golf course parking lot including new concrete curb and gutter, asphalt pavement, and LED lighting as indicated in the project Bid documents.

Project Completion: The Golf Course Parking lot shall begin construction by 5/1/20 (or earlier if possible), and shall be substantially completed by 6/26/20. The boathouse drive (segment 03) shall be begin construction 5/1/20 or earlier and shall be substantially completed 7/17/20. Landscaping shall be substantially completed by 7/31/20 for the entire project. Contractor shall maintain existing lighting or provide temporary lighting until the permanent light poles are installed.
