The KK Bus Garage project is an HVAC equipment replacement project that includes demolition of the existing system consisting of nine (9) air handling units and exhaust fans and multiple make-up air units. The new work will consist of adding fifteen (15) make-up air units, multiple exhaust fans, and a modernization of the building controls. A new stair and roof hatch will be added as an alternative for access to the new roof mounted equipment as indicated on contract bid documents, plans and specifications.

Project Completion: Work of Contract shall be Substantially Complete within 210 calendar days.
