MKE Taxiway Rehabilitation and Removal

Contract Description: This project includes pavement rehabilitation or pavement removals on multiple taxiways at Milwaukee County's General Mitchell International Airport (MKE). Included in this contract is substantial grading, construction of underdrains, asphalt, landscaping, pavement marking, and airfield electrical changes.

Project Completion:

If the Base Bid and all two (2) additive alternates are awarded, the contractor shall have a total of 172 consecutive calendar days to substantially complete the project, excluding punchlist. If any or all additive alternatives are not awarded, the total contract time shall be as follows:

Base Bid Only = 111 Calendar Days

Base Bid + Additive Alternative 1 = 111 Calendar Days

Base Bid + Additive Alternative 1 + Additive Alternative 2 = 172 Calendar Days

All contract time includes 31 days for a project shutdown from July 1 through July 31, 2024.
