Contract Description: This project includes roofing removal and replacement on multiple roofs at Milwaukee County's General Mitchell International Airport (MKE). The work areas include the Concourse D stem, portions of the Concourse D Hammerhead, and other areas. Included in this contract is removal of existing roofing membranes, ballast, and insulation, and replacement with new fully adhered vapor barriers, insulation, and membrane.

Project Completion:

If the Base Bid only is awarded, the contractor shall have a total of 150 consecutive calendar days to substantially complete the project, excluding punch list. If any or all additive alternatives are awarded, the contractor shall have a total of 180 consecutive calendar days to substantially complete the project, excluding punch list.
