QUESTION ASKED:

Question: Under the **Automobile Liability**, it reads “All Autos”. Based upon discussions with our Insurance Professionals, this language does not exist in a business auto policy. It is either “All Owned Autos” or “Any Auto”. Our current policies cover “All Owned Autos”. Coverage for “Any Auto” would be very difficult to attain and would certainly preclude most, if not all potential vendors from bidding provided it is enforced for all competitors.

In reference to **Professional Liability**; we ask that this requirement be struck for the reason that no employees of non-emergency transportation providers hold themselves out as medical professionals. Should a driver be involved in a situation in which they must render first aid, it is believed they would be protected from liability by the Good Samaritan statutes.

The **Umbrella Liability** insurance would be very difficult to obtain and excessively expensive. The minimums also specify a “following form” contract. This too will be difficult to obtain and excessively expensive. The annual cost of such an Umbrella Liability policy in our case would exceed the total revenue generated by this contract over the five year term (based on our historical figures).

Among our industry counterparts, we believe that any that desires to comply with the terms and conditions of the contract would be unable to answer this bid request. Therefore, we ask that you please revisit the Insurance Minimums and determine if there would be some flexibility in these key areas. If amendments can be made, we will immediately proceed with preparation of a bid proposal.
